Dr. Boyd is a board-certified pediatric dentist practicing in Chicago. He is also an attending instructor in the residency-training program in Pediatric Dentistry at Lurie Children's Hospital where he additionally serves as a member of

Lurie's Craniofacial Anomalies and Sleep Medicine teams. Prior to completing his dental degree from Loyola University's Chicago College of Dentistry in 1986, he obtained an advanced degree (M.Sc.) in Human Nutrition and Dietetics from Michigan State University. Dr. Boyd attended the University of Iowa for his post-graduate residency training in Pediatric Dentistry.
